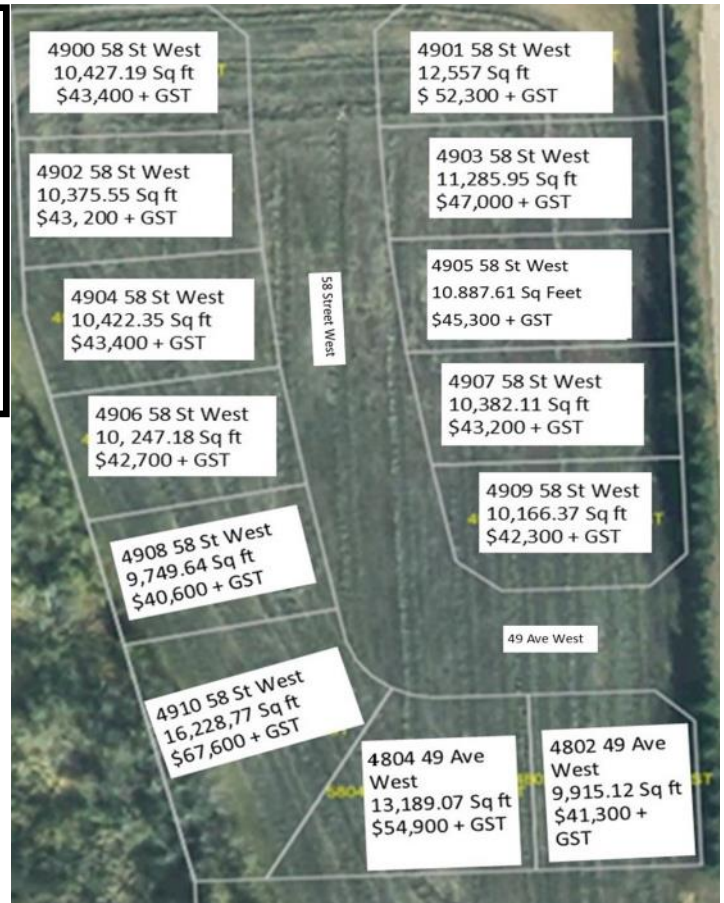

WHAT TO DO IN CASE OF A NATURAL GAS EMERGENCY: ATCO EMERGENCY LINE 1-800-511-3447

Smell Natural Gas? A Pungent, rotten egg odour is added to natural gas so it is detected for safety reasons.

If you smell gas inside a building:

LEAVE IMMEDIATELY
LEAVE LIGHTS AND APPLIANCES ALONE
CALL ATCO OR 911 ONCE YOU ARE OUTSIDE

If you smell gas outside a building:

CALL ATCO OR 911 IMMEDIATELY
KEEP PEOPLE AWAY FROM THE AREA
DO NOT SMOKE OR LIGHT ANY FLAMES

No Heat:

Call ATCO's emergency line but in the meantime, take care using other heat sources.
Indoor electric heaters are safe
Avoid wood fireplaces (you need to open a nearby window)
Never use outdoor barbecues, kerosene heaters or camping heaters indoors (they emit carbon monoxide)
