The Alberta RCMP is launching the Community Assisted Policing Through Use of Recorded Evidence (CAPTURE) program in all rural communities in Alberta.

CAPTURE allows members of the public to register their home or business security cameras with the RCMP with the goal of reducing the time it would take for an investigator to locate potential video evidence. Investigators will be able to view a map of registered security cameras in order to determine whether any are in the vicinity of a crime scene. Investigators can then contact the registered owner of the camera and arrange with them to obtain a copy of the video.
